Neuberger Berman unit acquires stake in EnCap Investments

Dyal Capital Partners acquired a roughly 20% stake in EnCap Investments LP, *The Wall Street Journal* reported Dec.23, citing "people familiar with the deal."

Dyal Capital, a private equity unit of Neuberger Berman, paid between \$700 million and \$800 million for the purchase, according to thereport, citing "a person familiar with the situation."

EnCap Investments is a private equity firm based in Houstonthat provides capital to oil and gas companies, the *Journal* said.

Dyal Capital also made a passive, minority in Vista EquityPartners in July.
